WHEN DOES DUTY **OF CARE APPLY?**

You're still responsible to check how that business deals with your waste.

HOW DO I STORE IT BEFORE COLLECTION?



ENSURE

IT'S STORED AND LABELLED PROPERLY SO NOTHING CAN ESCAPE SUCH AS LITTER, LIQUIDS OR ODOUR



PREVENT ACCESS

TO IT BY OTHERS, eg IN A LOCKED BIN OR SECURED COMPOUND



IN SPECIALISED CONTAINERS

IF REQUIRED eg HYGIENE WASTE, LIQUID WASTE OR HAZARDOUS WASTF



IF IN DOUBT

ASKYOUR WASTE CONTRACTOR FIRST, THEN YOUR **ENVIRONMENTAL** AGENCY OFFICE OR LOCAL **AUTHORITY**

WHICH WASTES NEED TO BE KEPT APART?

HOW SHOULD I MOVE MYWASTE?

Your waste carrier or waste contractor will arrange the movement of your waste. If you intend to move it yourself you will need to be registered as a waste carrier, Each waste stream will have its own requirement for transport and will need to be addressed separately.

Hazardous or hygiene / healthcare wastes will have to be compliant with the Carriage of Dangerous Goods.

ELECTRONIC WASTE

Like phones, computers, TV's, sound systems, fridges

Like batteries, acid, oils, some light bulbs
